THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC PROHIBITIONS ON THE WICK STREETS) ORDER 2022

NOTICE is hereby given that The Highland Council, by virtue of the powers conferred under Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended has made the above Order temporarily prohibiting all vehicular traffic from using Wick Streets.

As detailed below

Lengths of road affected by temporary prohibition of use

When identified by means of one or more of the traffic signs of a type generally provided for under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended; C1041 Louisburgh Street, U3651 Shore Lane, C1041 Church Street, U5511 Mowat Lane, U3482 Bon Accord Street, U3652 Sinclair Drive, U3658 Waverley Road, U3473 Bay View, U3577 Leishman Avenue, U3502 Corner Crescent, U3547 Henrietta Street, U3443 Anderson Drive, U3628 Owen Place, U3678 Tollbooth Lane, U3523 Glamis Road and U3647 Victoria Place.

Temporary prohibition on use of a road

From 18:00 hours on 16 December 2022 to 18:00 hours on 15 May 2023 no person shall drive, or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the lengths of road, or a part or parts of the lengths of road, specified above and executed as relative to this Order when a prohibition is identified as applying by means of one or more of the traffic signs of a type generally provided for under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The road closure is necessary to permit works on the water mains.

Exemptions

No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to:

- (a) Vehicles employed to carry out the works in respect of which this Order is made, including those vehicles employed to carry out associated traffic management.
- (b) Emergency Vehicles.

Alternative Routes

No alternative route provided.
